How to Log in to GCSEPod

To access GCSEPod for the first time, you should follow these simple steps:

- Go to <u>www.gcsepod.com</u> and click Login in the top right hand corner.
- 2. Click New to GCSEPod? Get started.
- 3. Select Student.

- 4. Enter your name, date of birth and type the school name. Northgate High School should appear in a dropdown list. Click on the school in this list to confirm it.
- 5. Select a **username** (use your school computer log in to make it easy for you), **password**, and a **password hint** to help you remember the password.
- 6. Select the **subjects** you study.
- 7. Add your school email address as a **recovery email** address.

How to access assignments that you have been set.

An assignment is a piece of work that your teacher has set for you to complete on the GCSEPod website.

It could include a playlist of podcasts for you to watch and some questions for you to answer.

The questions may be multiple choice, which will be marked immediately, or free text, which your teacher will mark on the website for you.



5. Watch the Pods by clicking on the arrow by the title or on the pod. Answer any questions that you have been set underneath the pods.

How to use GCSEPod to be responsible for your own learning.



How to make the most of watching the pods.

1. Watch a Pod once and then **list 5 or more pieces of information** from memory. Watch it a second time to check the information you remembered is correct. **Aim to improve** on this score next time.

Stretch: Can you add another 3+ pieces of information after your second watch?

2. Write a one paragraph summary of the pod, selecting the key points. Stretch: Can you quote or reference the Pod?

3. Create a **spider diagram or mind map** of the information in the Pod. Making it as colourful as possible will help you visualise it later. See below for an example of a spider diagram!

Stretch: Can you link this spider diagram or mind map to another Pod, building on it with the new information from each Pod you watch?

Stretch: Can you justify why you would include the information you did?









5. Select pieces of information from a Pod and **rank the information in order of importance** with the most important at the top and the least important at the bottom.

Stretch: Write at least two sentences justifying why you have ranked it this way.



6. Watch a topic, title or single Pod and create a set of around 6–8 symbols to represent the key pieces of information. Annotate your symbols.
 For example, for Romeo and Juliet you might have some of the following:



7. Watch a Pod or group of Pods and come up with **20 quiz questions and answers** to ask a friend.

Stretch: Complete this activity with a friend. Only allow them to watch each Pod once – how many do they get right? Then get them to create a new test for you to answer.



- 8. Create personal playlists for each subject:
 - Red = topics I'm least confident with
 - Amber = topics I'm ok with
 - **Green** = topics I'm most confident with
- 9. Reduce the **key information** in a Pod to **12 words**.



10. Sort the information in a Pod into 2–3 categories then think of a title for each one.
