Microsoft Teams Expectations

Some teachers and pastoral staff may provide some online face-to-face sessions to enhance your learning where this is appropriate to the material being taught. If you are invited to a live, online session, you are expected to observe the following rules:

- Student cameras will be automatically turned off, unless you are a Sixth Form Student. Sixth
 Formers have the option of having their cameras on or off and should be dressed appropriately for
 learning.
- All students should be in an environment that is quiet, safe and free from distractions (preferably not a bedroom).
- You should be on time for your interactive session and remain attentive during the lesson or feedback session.
- You must interact patiently and respectfully with your teachers and peers. Please be aware that
 teachers will record online learning sessions. These can be made available to students who miss the
 session. Any cases of inappropriate behaviour will result in students being removed from the online
 platform and parents will be informed.

Using Microsoft Teams

You will receive an email from your teacher to let you know that you have been invited to a live online session using the Microsoft Teams app. It will tell you what day and time the session will be and will invite you to respond.

You may need to download the Microsoft Teams App. Visit www.office.com and log in with your school email and password. This is free.
