

**Year 10 practice exam day**  
**Friday 19th April 2024**

Dear Parent/Carer

On Friday 19<sup>th</sup> April, Year 10 will complete mock exams in English and maths. The purpose of this day is to give students experience of completing larger assessments, as a whole year group, in an exam venue. It will also give students with access arrangements an opportunity to rehearse their use.

The schedule for the day will be as follows:

08:45 Students to arrive at exam venue.

09:00 English exam starts. Students will go to the dining hall for a break when they come out of the exam, before going to their Period 2 lesson.

11:55 Students go to Period 3 for the first part of the lesson.

12:35 Early lunch. Students will have access to the dining facilities.

13:15 Students to arrive at exam venue.

13:30 Maths exam starts. Students will be free to leave school when the assessment finishes. For students on standard timings this will be at approximately 15:00 – for those with extra time, a little later.

Exams for most students will take place in the Sports Centre. **Students with extra time access arrangements should go to the main venue. However, if their SEN access arrangement includes use of a laptop, scribe or reader, they should report to A32 at least 15 mins before the start time.**

We would appreciate your support in ensuring your child has the correct equipment and arrives on time for their exam wearing full school uniform. Students should only have a bottle of water that is clear and has no label. Exam boards stress that it is the responsibility of the student to come with the correct equipment, so we recommend that a clear pencil case with black biros, ruler, protractor, a pair of compasses, pencil, rubber and a calculator should be brought to all assessments. We will not be loaning any equipment to students. We would ask that students ensure that they visit the toilet prior to taking their exams, as toilet breaks should only be taken in an emergency or in case of medical need.

In accordance with the exam board regulations, candidates are not permitted to take a mobile phone, or any other 'potential technological/web-enabled sources of information' into the exam venue. Watches of any kind are no longer permitted in the exam room.
