



- 17 % = "Missing equipment / PE kit / ingredients".




How long are you spending on homework each day?





Which of these best describes how you are coping with your homework and revision?



- Never I find it hard to motivate myself and rarely do much revision






Reading and Literacy

Accelerated Reader

- Targeted books, based on reading age/comprehension.
 - Books in library are colour-coded.
- Happens:
 - during English lessons
 - during form time
 - homework set weekly
- Quizzing:
 - Online can be at home
 - Individual login
 - Points collected individually
 - Termly targets for each pupil



The Importance of Reading

Why embed a reading culture?

- Improves enjoyment and confidence.
- 15 minutes of daily reading is shown to lead to strong progress.
- Strong links to improving mental health and a sense of belonging.
- Enhances empathy.
- Better sleeping patterns.



What Can Parents Do?

- Keep showing an interest
 - including plus/minus points
- Encourage and praise
- Help with organisation
 - e.g. Pack bags the evening before
- Provide a quiet place to work
- Check homework completion and help interpret tasks
- Support school messages

The 5 pillars of success

- 1. Attendance
- 2. Growth mindset know you can get there

1. Attendance

Laying strong foundations for excellent progress

- Excellent attendance is essential for positive progress
- Students with less than 80% attendance averaged 1.93 grades below expectation
- This is 1.33 grades per subject below the progress of students who had 95% or greater attendance

2. Mindset Knowing you can get there

Instead of:

I'm not good at math


I messed up

Say:

I'm not good at math yet

What can you learn from this?

The principle of **growth mindset** tells us it's possible to grow and change, and get better at things you find hard with the right kind of practice.



3. Organisation and Homework

Laying strong foundations for independent learning

- Being organised the night before supporting your child to manage their day and their homework
- Students with an average homework score below 3.5 averaged 1.28 grades below expectation
- This was 0.66 grades per subject below the progress of students with an average homework score of 4.5 or higher

Laying strong foundations for independent learning

- Students with an average homework score below 2.5 averaged 2.36 grades below expectation.
- This was 1.66 grades per subject below the progress of students with an average homework score of 4.5 or higher

The average student loses 8 minutes out of every study hour to smartphone distraction, and just having a smartphone on the desk makes students score lower on IQ tests. Make them put the phones away! Their work will improve in quality, and they'll get through it faster, enjoying more leisure time as a result.



4. Resilience

Laying strong foundations for coping with challenges

- We are not born with resilience
- Every child has the capacity to become resilient
- Resilience is the process of adapting well in the face of change, trauma or stress

Top tips for building resilience

- Build positive relationships spend quality time with friends and loved ones, completing shared passions together
- Build emotional awareness encourage your child to understand, express and manage their emotions, and to talk about them with you
- Build independence help your child learn to be independent in their actions and thoughts – this improves self-esteem and self-confidence
- Build confidence encourage challenges and allow your child to learn from them, even if they do not complete them fully

5. Other interests

Having a support network beyond school

- Young people who have an interest/s beyond school are better able to adapt when issues arise at school
- Our students need a different forum where they can develop their self-esteem, sense of self-worth, self-confidence and have a network of non-school peers


